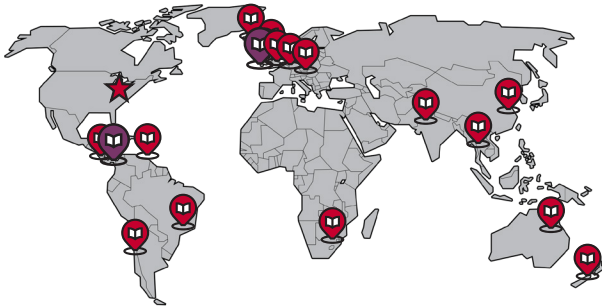


Education Abroad

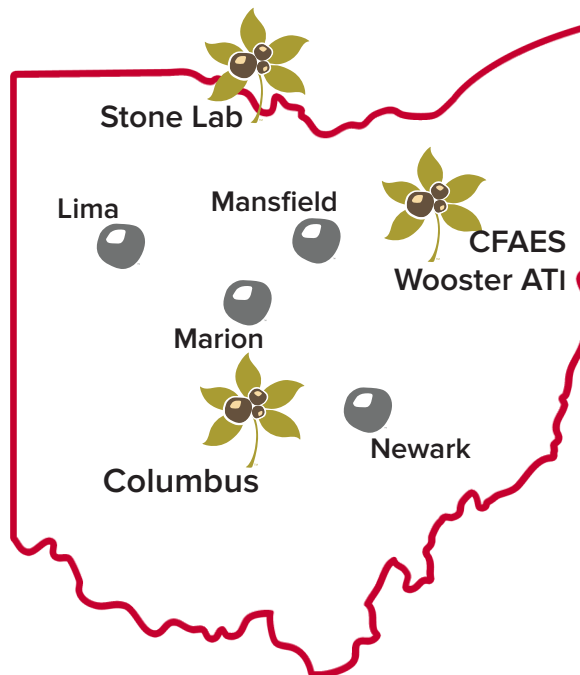

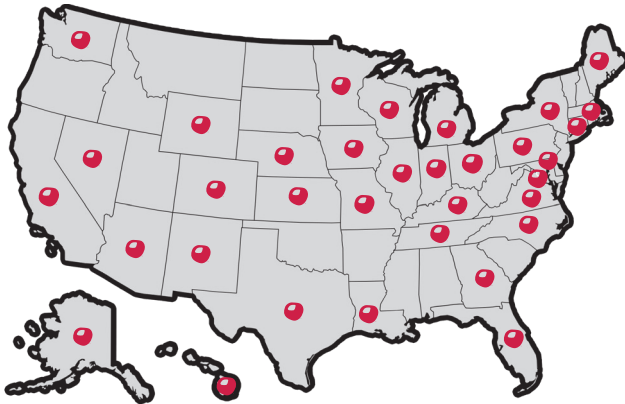

- **4** Countries



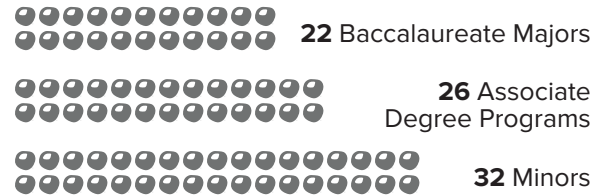
Career Outcomes for Graduates

- **12.9%** are continuing their education

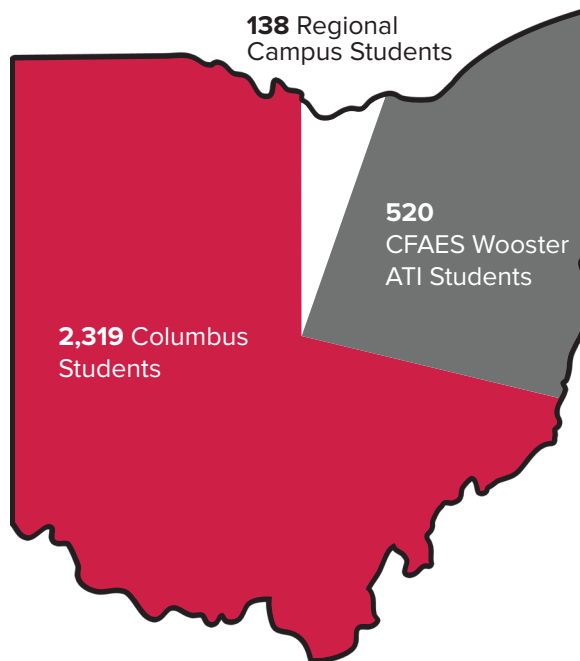


Academics at CFAES Columbus and CFAES Wooster ATI

Total enrollment: **2,977** students

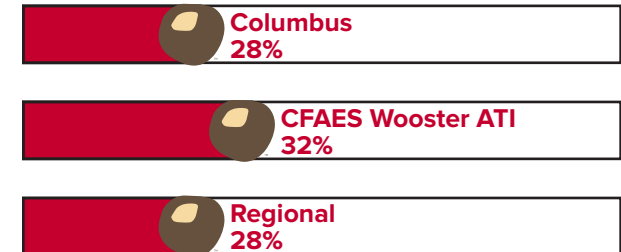


- In-state enrollment: **90%**
