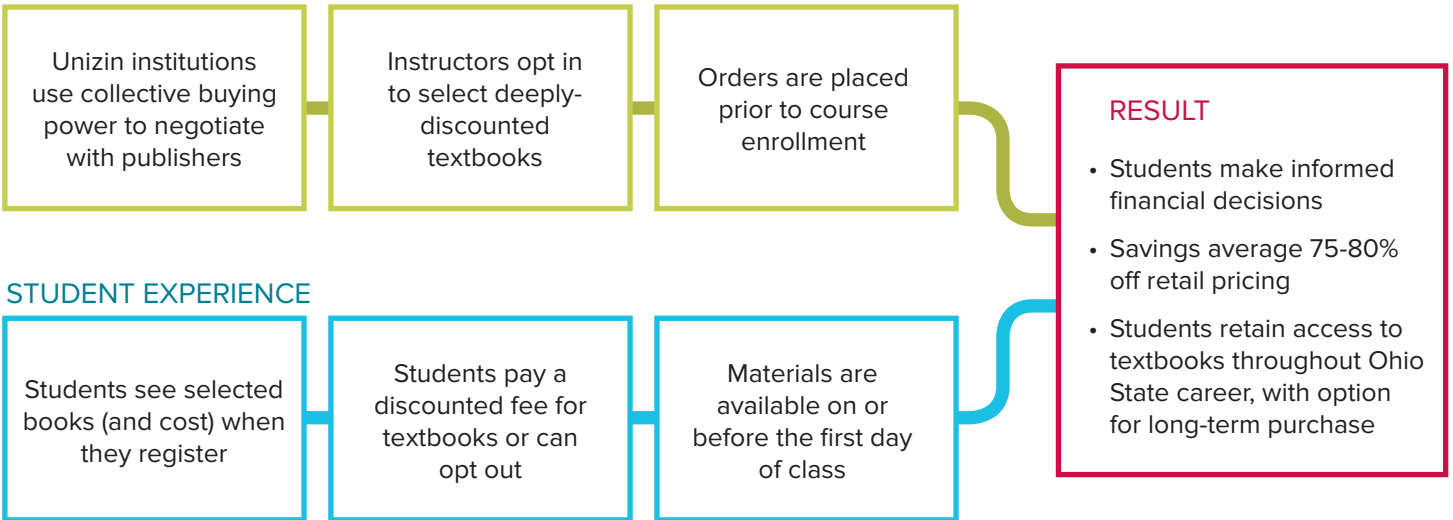


REDUCING TEXTBOOK COSTS with CarmenBooks

Learning Experience

Students who delay textbook purchases start the semester at a disadvantage. By making texts available on or before the first day of class, students are positioned for success from day one.

Inclusive Access

All students in a course using CarmenBooks have access to their digital learning materials on or before the first day of class through CarmenCanvas. Students pay for course materials through a fee, noted during course registration.

Savings

Publisher materials provided through CarmenBooks are made available to students at a negotiated rate. Through CarmenBooks, the average textbook is around \$35, which is 77% less than the average GE textbook price at Ohio State.
