The person selected must complete an "internship" of at least one semester in one phase of the pork and swine industry. The minimum cash award will be \$1,200 (\$600 prior to the internship and \$600 after satisfactory completion of the internship).

INTERNSHIP

1. It is a requirement that the recipient of this award participate in a full-time, earning-learning work experience (hereinafter called an internship) for a minimum of one semester.
2. The internship will be served **off-campus** with an organization in the pork industry, (e.g., a swine farm, a meat packer, a firm marketing swine or pork products) and designed to support the future career interest of the recipient.
3. The recipient will be required to complete the internship before graduating with the degree toward which the candidate is currently working.
4. If the recipient wishes to receive academic credit for the internship, he/she must make the necessary arrangements with a faculty adviser prior to starting the internship. The amount of credit received will be consistent with the policy established by the department or institute.
5. If assistance is needed, the Committee will help the selected candidate locate a cooperating organization for the internship.

ELIGIBILITY

Undergraduate and graduate students in The Ohio State University, College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences, and the Agricultural Technical Institute (Wooster) are eligible.

CRITERIA

The person selected must have an interest in the Pork Industry. Scholarship, financial need and moral character will be considered.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

The selection of the recipient is to be made upon the recommendation of a committee consisting of two industry representatives, one person appointed by the Chairman of the Animal Sciences Dept. (OSU), and one person representing the Dean's Office of the College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences. The selection committee will request interviews with selected final applicants.
