## ***QUALIFICATION CRITERIA***

### **To qualify for an initial award, a student should**

- Be a native of Dominica (preferably) and graduate of a high school there; in the event that no students from Dominica apply or qualify, then consideration will be given first to students from islands that comprise the Organization of Eastern Caribbean States (OECS), including Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, British Virgin Islands, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Kitts and Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent, and The Grenadines; if no students from these islands apply or qualify, then consideration will be given to otherwise qualified students from Bahamas, Barbados, Jamaica, Trinidad and Tobago.
- Be accepted into a Food Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, or environmental Sciences course of study at The Ohio State University as a full time student – preferably as an undergraduate student or be accepted into the University with the intention of entering an FAES Program. Should the candidate not enter an FAES Program by the end of his or her sophomore year, any remaining scholarship benefits will be terminated.
- Preferably, but not mandatorily be a first generation college student (i.e. one neither of whose parents shall have graduated from college).
- Demonstrate integrity, dependability, consideration of others, cooperation with fellow students, with teachers, and with the community.
- Demonstrate a sincere interest in and concern for the preservation and improvement of food, agricultural, and environmental endeavors in the Caribbean islands.

### **To qualify for a renewal award, the student should have**

- Continued in a Food Sciences, Agricultural Sciences, or Environmental Sciences course of study at the Ohio State University as a full time student.
- Maintained an approximate ‘B’ grade point average, or the equivalent.
- Continued to demonstrate integrity, dependability, consideration of others, cooperation with fellow students, with teachers and with the community.
- Continued to demonstrate a sincere interest in and concern for the preservation and improvement of food, agricultural, and environmental endeavors in the Caribbean islands.
