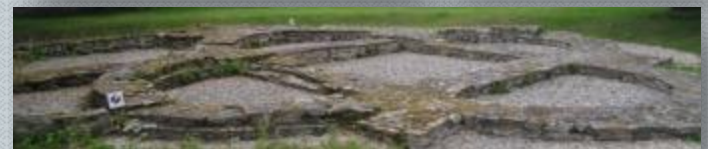

Learn about the impact of economic policy on the decisions that business owners make regarding sustainability.

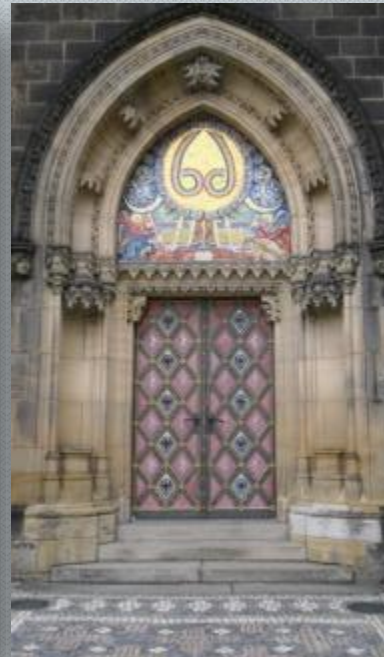




# The Location

# ELIGIBILITY



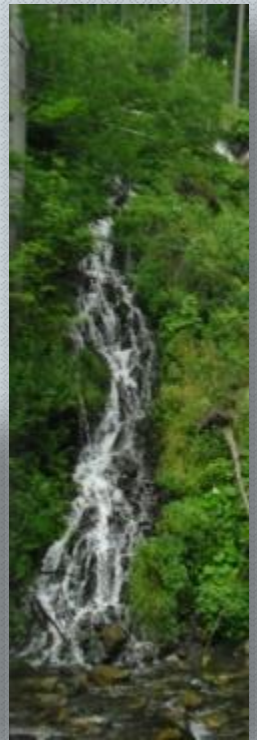
- This program is open to both graduate and undergraduate students of any major with a 2.5 minimum GPA.
- Personal interviews will be required.
- There is no language prerequisite for this program.
- Lessons in survival Czech is part of the coursework.





# COURSES & CREDITS

- Students will earn 6 semester hours of graded Ohio State credit.
- The credit: Agricultural Economics 5797 (3) and CFAES 5797 (3).

For flexibility, you are able to book your own flight

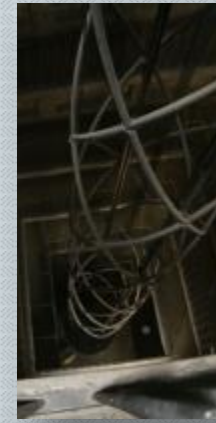




# FINANCIAL AID and SCHOLARSHIPS

If you are currently an eligible student paying fees at Ohio State for at least half-time enrollment in an officially recognized Ohio State study abroad program, you will be able to receive most forms of federal, state, and university controlled financial aid.

- ❖ Can use FASFA based aid (6 hours minimum)
- ❖ CFAES Scholarships
- ❖ Gilman Scholarship (Pell eligible)
- ❖ Wolfe Scholarship (Ohio high school, 10% award rate)
